Main objective	RECAP is a continuous data collection system designed to understand and monitor the characteristics of psychoactive substance users who are managed by professionals in care, support, and prevention centers for addiction (CSAPA). The data collected is essential for public authorities to help define and evaluate their policies in the field of drugs, particularly to identify trends in service utilization. The national data should also serve to inform the reflections of care professionals on their own actions.
Inclusion criteria	The national data collection concerns any person with an addiction problem, with or without substance use, who has undergone at least one intervention in the facility that welcomed them during the year. The notion of intervention is very broad here, as even the initial reception can be considered an intervention. Individuals who use substances and are seen in young consumers' consultations are also included in the data collection.
