Submodule A1 is intended for individuals who do not have any illnesses or handicaps caused or aggravated by work, while submodule A2 addresses individuals who have one or more illnesses, one or more of which were caused or aggravated by work. Module B is dedicated to workplace accidents that have occurred within the last twelve months, for individuals who have worked during this period. Module C has to do with the specific jobs and administrative procedures for the recognition of an illness or handicap. Lastly, module D has to do with the risks at the surveyed individual's workplace. 37,392 individuals completed the survey.
